Today, it is estimated that there are millions of listeners and viewers of the annual Festival of Nine lessons and Carols from Kings College Chapel worldwide.

The Nine lessons and Carols format had its beginnings in the early 1900's and its popularity spread such that it is now performed around the world

The Carols performed by the Choral Society in this presentation will range from the traditional to present day compositions, and the service will include timehonored carols for congregational singing.
